Boarding Nursery and Primary School N60,500

For small children who are not able to take care of themselves (in areas like toiletry, bathing, washing their clothes and sometimes even eating) there is an extra charge of Ten thousand (N10,000) Naira per term.

#### Malamin College Gboko

Day Secondary School N25,000 Boarding Secondary School N60,500

Payment should be made ahead of resumption day. On arrival at the school, parents will be required to show evidence of payments at the Registration Desk. Payment must be made directly to the bank.

#### PTA Project Support Fund

The PTA has decided to build a 3-Classroom Block at the School. The General Meeting of the PTA by majority vote agreed that with effect from First Term, every parent should pay N3,000 per student per year. You may pay the

N3,000 per student at once or you may choose to pay N1,000 per student per term.
